The Catholic Education System as part of a Whole School Improvement Framework is adopting a Quality Catholic Schooling Review Process which will provide a lens for each area of school life across the areas of:

The process is school driven and is embedded in a culture of seeking improvement at local level with an aim to improve outcomes for students.
